This haze also occasionally occurs during the calm hours of the evening. From the southward a vessel should not shoal into less than 12 or 11 fathoms between Port Chaul and Khandari Island, as in the vicinity From the Southward., ., f large fishing stakes extend some distance from the coast. When Khandari Island bears southward of east a course may be steered for the outer light vessel, which can be passed at a convenient distance on either side; thence a N. E. N. course will lead to the anchorage east of Sunk Rock, or proceed further up the harbour to the usual mooring...



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
